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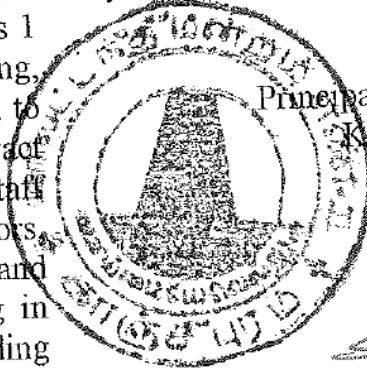

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner. Also, perused the records. On perusal of the plaint document nos.16 and 17, the respondents 1 to 3 had proceeded sit-in-strike inside the factory.

Therefore, it is prima facie clear from the supra documents that the respondents 1 to 3 are indulged for strike in the premises of the petitioner's company especially the petition schedule property. If the acts of the respondents 1 to 3 namely such as preventing, threatening or causing any obstruction to the workers, casual and contract labourers, contractors, supervisors, staff members, managers, directors, customers, consultants, advisors and visitors of the petitioner, assembling in the main entrance, holding demonstration, shouting slogans, assembling by tying flags, hoisting flags, stopping the movement of vehicles and the ingress and egress for the personnel of the petitioner in to the petition schedule property is not restrained by an order of this Court, petitioner and its personnel may suffer to irreparable loss which cannot be compensated in any mode. In view of the petitioner establishing its prima facie case as to the interference caused in the above said manner and, also due to the balance of convenience exists in favour of the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant the relief of ad-interim injunction restraining the respondents, its men, agents or servants or any one acting on its behalf from assembling in the main

entrance, holding any demonstration, shouting slogans, assembling by tying flags, hoisting flags, stay in or sit in within the radius of 300 meters of the petitioner's premises, stopping ingress and egress of the petitioner and its personnel, stopping the movement of vehicles inside and outside of the petition schedule property, stopping the removal of raw materials, semi-finished goods, finished goods and machineries till 14.07.2025. Petitioner shall comply the statutory requirements as envisaged Order XXXIX Rule 3(a) and (b) of CPC. Issue notice to the respondent through Court and post on payment of batta in a day. Call on 14.07.2025.
